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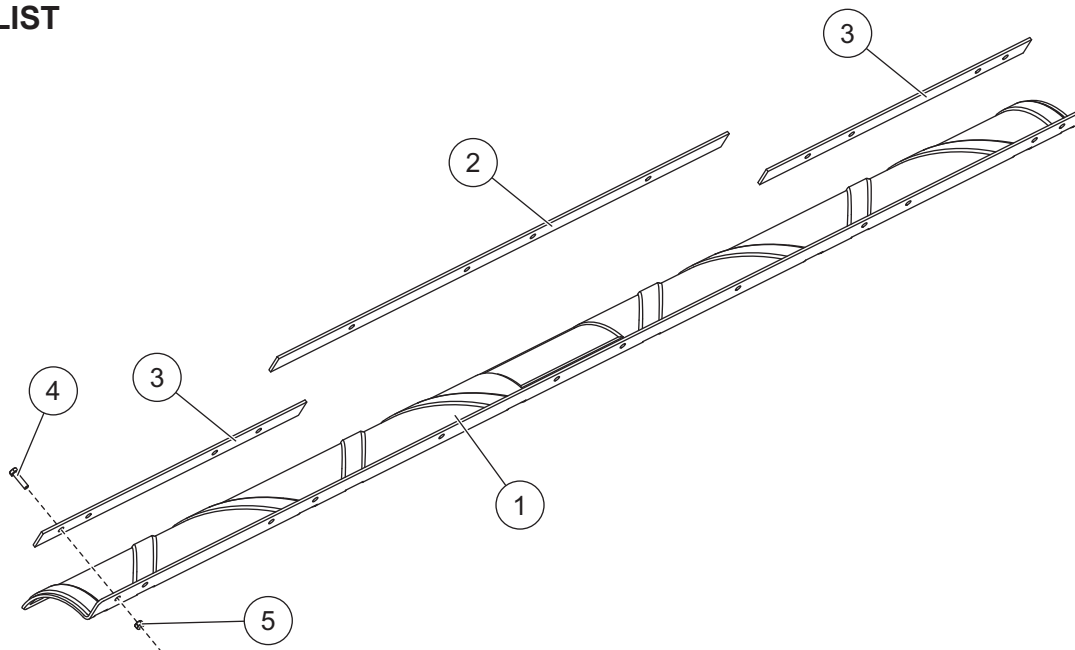

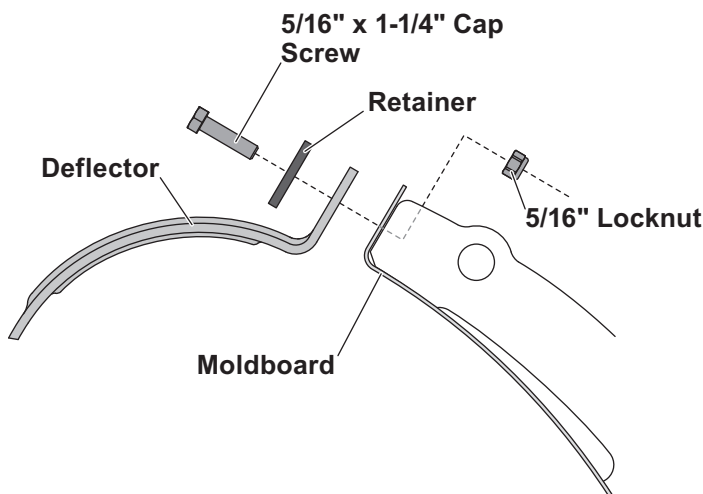

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Lower the blade to the ground, and turn the control to the "OFF" position. Disconnect the snowplow from the vehicle, or turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.
2. Place the deflector on top of the moldboard and align the deflector holes with the corresponding holes in the moldboard.
3. Place the retainers on top of the deflector and blade as shown. Fasten the retainers and deflector to the snowplow with 5/16" x 1-1/4" cap screws and locknuts, making sure the retainers are tight against the deflector and moldboard. Torque fasteners to 18 ft-lb.



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
